May 6 – May 28

Monday – Thursday 4:30pm to 8:30pm
Friday 4:30pm to 9pm
Saturday, Sunday 10am to 9pm

Note: The competition pool will be blocked off May 8th – May 26th (Mon – Fri) from 4pm to 6:30pm for Swim Team practice. During practice, the family pool will be available for use during guarded hours beginning at 4:30pm Mon – Fri.

May 29 – August 6

Pool is open daily from 10am to 9pm

Note: The competition pool will be blocked off May 30th – June 30th (Mon – Fri) from 8:30am to 11:30am for Swim Team practice. During practice, the family pool will be available for use during guarded hours beginning at 10am.

August 7 – September 3

Monday – Thursday Pool is closed
Friday 4:30pm to 8:30pm
Saturday, Sunday 10am to 9pm

LABOR DAY– September 4

10am to 9pm

September 5 – September 10

Tuesday – Friday Pool is closed
Saturday, Sunday 11am to 8pm

Remember all pool parties with 12+ guests will need to request an additional lifeguard. For all pool party requests please visit www.SweetWaterPools.net and click on “Pool Parties” on top menu bar, then “Pool Party Request Form.” The cost is \$25/hour for each additional lifeguard. THE AMENITY AREAS ARE FOR HOMEOWNERS IN GOOD STANDING ONLY. IF YOU HAVE A BALANCE ON YOUR HOA ACCOUNT, YOU, YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS, TENANTS OR GUESTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO USE ANY OF THE POOL OR COMMON AREA AMENITIES.

GENERAL

1. The Lifeguard is in charge and has full authority to enforce all rules, both written and unwritten. In serious cases of misconduct, security and/or Police Department will be called. In cases involving small children the parents/security shall be called.
2. NO SMOKING
3. All pool facilities are for the sole use of Laurel Springs's homeowners and their guests. Owners may have up to five (5) guests at one time. Anything over five (5) guests is considered a pool party and you will need to fill out and submit a Pool Party Request Form to Property Management. This information can be found on the HOA website www.LaurelSpringsHOA.com under AMENITIES, Pool Information.
4. Absolutely NO GLASS, sharp objects or hazardous materials inside the pool area. You will be warned once, then fined \$25 if problem persists.
5. Horseplay, running, pushing, dunking, rough play or excessive splashing is not permitted.
6. No spitting, spouting or blowing nose in the water.
7. Please shower before entering the pool. The shower is located near the wading pool.
8. Admission to the pool will be refused to anyone with open wounds, skin conditions, eye infections or any communicable condition or diarrheal illness.
9. Profanity, improper behavior, or vulgar remarks are prohibited.
10. Keep your guests to a minimum number at one time or you'll need to register for a pool party. See Party Rules.
11. The Lifeguard may prohibit the use of floats at his/her discretion.
12. Calling for "help" when not in need of help is forbidden.
13. Lifeguard stands are off limits to anyone, except the Lifeguards.

GENERAL *(continued)*

14. Diving is NOT permitted.
15. No tennis balls or other such round, hard toys allowed in the pool.
16. Only 17 years of age and older are allowed in the pool during "Free Swim." During this time use of pool is "SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK". Release forms are available on HOA website (www.LaurelSpringsHOA.com), at main gate or Property Management Office.
17. No pets allowed inside the pool area. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS.
18. No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs is allowed in the pool area. **Underage drinking of alcohol is strictly prohibited.** Intoxication grants immediate removal; a second violation of this rule will prohibit access to the pool area for the remaining pool season.
19. Children under the age of 12 **MUST** be accompanied and supervised by an adult resident over the age of eighteen (18) years at all times. This will be strictly enforced.
20. For the purpose of keeping the pool and pool deck sanitary and free of pests, please clean up after yourself and dispose of all trash properly. This has been a real problem. Fines and/or suspension of privileges may occur for abuse. Notify a Lifeguard if the trash cans are FULL or have attracted pests, such as ants. This is part of the Lifeguards' pool duties.
21. Food and drinks are strictly prohibited within three (3) feet of the pool.
22. No bikes, scooters, skateboards or any other wheeled devices are allowed into the pool area. This ruling includes all manual and powered wheeled devices. Racks are provided outside the pool area and are to be used at all times.
23. Any small child not fully potty trained or less than thirty-six (36) months of age must have a swim diaper and rubber pants on at all times upon entering any of the pools. **THIS IS FOR YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY.**
24. Only proper bathing suits may be worn in the pool. Cut-offs and/or shorts or belts are NOT allowed. They damage the pool and slide surfaces. Bathing attire is required for all ages.
25. Residents/Guests who cause damage and/or do not comply with the pool rules may be fined and banned from the pool area.



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WADING POOL

1. Parents are responsible for children in the wading pool. The wading pool is not guarded; therefore, parents must be at the wading pool watching their children.
2. Children age 5 and under are allowed to use the wading pool.

SLIDE

1. All riders must be at least 48" tall or have prior approval from the Lifeguard on duty to ride the water slide.
2. **ONLY ONE PERSON ON SLIDE AT A TIME!** Human chains are strictly forbidden.
3. Riders must wait for the signal of the Lifeguard before starting the ride. Please obey stationed Lifeguard at all times!
4. Wait until the previous swimmer moves out of the way, toward the stairs before sliding. Otherwise, you could be injured or harm others.
5. Coast Guard Approved Lifejackets may be worn on the slide.
6. No boards/floats/devices of any type are allowed on the slide. No arm floaties, tubes, waist belts are permitted.
7. All riders must ride feet-first while in a seated or lying down on their back position. Absolutely **NO** riding on stomach or headfirst as serious spinal injury may occur.
8. Riders must keep their arms and hands inside the flumes at all times.
9. Riders may not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate, or stop in the slide.
10. Persons under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol are not permitted to use the slide.
11. **NO RUNNING!**
12. Caution: Riders must be in good health. Pregnant women or individuals with heart or back conditions should not use the slide.
13. Riders ride at their own risk.
14. If the slide water is off, the slide is **CLOSED**.



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SLIDE EXITING RULES

1. Riders may not block the end of the slide.
2. Riders must leave the splash pool quickly and orderly.
3. No swimming or flotation devices are allowed in the splash pool.

During the half days when the pool is open from 4:30pm to 8:30pm; the Lifeguards will only monitor the lap pool; and will be allowed a break early morning and early evening.
